Lexington District Four has scheduled the week of August 3 - 7 for LEAP (Learn, Evaluate, Analyze, Prepare) days to provide an *optional* day for students to return to school before the regularly scheduled first day of school. Virtual Students for LEAP Days

Students and parents will be able to pick up technology and information regarding the Virtual Program by driving through the Front Office Loop. All families will stay in their vehicles and office staff will be at the curbside to assist with materials checkout.

Hybrid Students for LEAP Day

Students will attend LEAP day based on the school's normal half-days schedule. Arrival time begins at 7:15 am and dismissal is 11:00 am. Transportation and meals will be provided. Students will attend in two groups to provide smaller class sizes. Group A will be 4K students and Group B will be 5K students.

Students will be oriented to new safety procedures and technology in order to be prepared for the beginning of instruction on August 17th. Parents will not attend these half-day sessions and will not be allowed to walk students to the classroom, due to COVID-19 safety guidelines. Car riders will be dropped off in their regular colored hallway car line. Car tags will be used from last year. If you need a new car tag, please contact the front office.
