A/B Hybrid Instructional Model and Virtual Instructional Model

- Teachers will meet students' learning needs in person or virtually.
- All classes will use state standards aligned learning materials and instructional tools.
- All students will have common content and assessments.
- All students will have the same grading structures.
- Attendance will be taken for all students.
- All students who qualify for services through an Individualized Education Program (IEP) will receive those services as required.
- Students taking upper level CTE courses will have opportunities to attend school on Fridays. Schedules for Fridays will be determined by students' teachers.

Hybrid Instructional Model

Cohort A will attend school on Mondays and Wednesdays.

Cohort B will attend school on Tuesday and Thursdays.

**Class schedules have been mailed to students. Students may find their cohort day information at the bottom the mailed schedule.

The first day of school for Cohort A day students is Monday, August 17.

The first day of school for Cohort B day students is Tuesday, August 18.

- Students will follow a daily schedule when participating in face-to-face instruction.
- Attendance will be taken daily. Virtual attendance is taken through participation such as turning in work, participating in Google Meets, completing learning reflections, etc.
- Face-to-Face instruction will occur 2 days per week.
- Virtual learning will occur 3 days a week. E-learning will supplement and extend face-to-face learning.
- Teachers will have scheduled office hours for virtual students. This time can be used to ask questions, respond to questions, one-on-one feedback, personalized instruction, etc.

This may include online meetings, live streamed lessons, pre-recorded lessons, etc. • Teachers will have scheduled office hours for virtual students. This could include turning in work, participating in Google Meets, completing learning reflections, etc.

Please see the guidelines on the Lexington School District Four's website. • Hand sanitizer is available in each teacher's classroom. • Custodial staff will use an electrostatic machine to disinfect classrooms periodically throughout the day. • Students' desks and/or chairs are spaced 6 feet apart in all classrooms. Desks and chairs are marked with tape to identify proper distancing. Teachers will enforce classroom dismissal procedures to allow for social distancing. • Social distancing stickers have been placed in main entrances and in hallways near restrooms to remind students and teachers of social distancing guidelines. • Water fountains will not be available for use. • Students are encouraged to bring a water bottle to school to refill from classroom sinks.
